Thus, the Fall 2010 MEAP reflects progress attained during the 2009-2010 school year.

² The MEAP consists of five subtests: Reading, Math, Writing, Science, and Social Studies. Of these, only Reading and Math are administered every year. In the interest of consistency, the columns labeled ELA have been populated with data only from the Reading subtest.

³ Because of the delay between test administration and the release of the results, data from the 2011 MEAP are not yet available.
